- Procurement Method is: Open Domestic Bidding.
- Tenderers must, in order to be considered for the award of the contract, be registered with the Public Procur Regulatory Authority (PPRA) in the following categories:
  - Code: 211 General Supplies, Sub-Code: 04 Uniform, Protective Clothing and General Clothing or Code: 213 General Manufacturers/Producers, Sub-Code: 09 Garments
- The tender is reserved for citizens or citizen contractors as stated under section 76 (2) (d) of the Procurement Act. Contractors must be domiciled within Botswana in the Mahalapye, Palapye, Tutume, Bobirwa, Serowe, Districts.
