

Republic of Botswana — Ministry of Transport and Public Works Expression of Interest for Dualling of A1 Road

PRIVATE PARTY TO PARTICIPATE IN PPP PROJECTS IDENTIFIED BY GOVERNMENT

- THE GOVERNMENT OF BOTSWANA IS EMBARKING on an initiative to solicit private party interest to
 partner with the Government to implement dualling of640km of A1 road from Ramatlabama to Ramokgwebana.
 This will be a Design-Build-Finance-Operate-Maintain or DBFOM contract where all the functions will be
 allocated to a private party.
- Interested private parties, within the infrastructure and built environment are invited to express their interest in
 the execution of such works and as such are to submit company details.
- The scope of work shall include the full scope of Engineering Procurement Construction and Management (EPCM) and Operation and Maintenance (O&M) services associated with facilities and infrastructure of identified projects. prospective private parties/investors will be required to meet the following objectives:
 - To review, develop and implement a PPP project governance model to ensure execution of projects within the desired time, cost and quality, in a transparent manner.
 - II. To secure financing and funding for the design, construction and maintenance.
 - III. To source the necessary core technical expertise required to ensure delivery of projects at the anticipated scale, with proven experience and professional capacity.
 - IV. To provide a service which will be paid for through user charges.
- The Expression of Interest is to be evaluated in 2024 following a closed tendering process for the pre-qualified
 private parties and subsequent commercial negotiations. The participating private parties will be expected to
 sign confidentiality agreements prior to receipt of any enquiry documents or discussions.
- The proposed contracting method shall be based on the Design-Build-Finance-Operate-Maintain or DBFOM contract.

Eligibility/Compliance

- In order to be considered for work associated with this project, interested parties must include the following compliance documentation as part of their submissions:
 - i) A certified copy of valid Tax Clearance Certificate from country of residence.
 - ii) A certified copy of Trading Licence from country of residence or equivalent.
 - iii) Provide company registration details from country of residence.
