

A WORKS CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC FENCING OF THE PHUDUHUDU COMMUNITY FARM IN THE NORTH-WEST DISTRICT COUNCIL

- TENDER OFFERS ARE INVITED from 100% citizen contractors for a works contract for the supply, delivery and installation of electric fencing of the Phuduhudu Community Farm in the North-West District Council.
- The Procuring Entity is: North-West District Council.
- Procurement Method is: Open Domestic Bidding.
- The tender is reserved for citizens or citizen contractors as stated under section 76 (2) of the Public Procurement Act. Bidders who are domiciled in Botswana and 100% citizens shall, in order to be considered for award of the contract, be registered with the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) in the following category: PPRA Code: 13 – Fencing, Sub-Code: 02 – Electrical Fencing, Grade: B.  
15% price preferential treatment for companies owned by target groups (youth, women and people with disability and rural settings and employment) shall apply on this tender.
- Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the competitive bidding procedures contained in the Public Procurement Act, 2021.
- The pre-tender estimate is BWP 2,700,000.00.
- A non-refundable fee of P250.00 (Two Hundred and Fifty Pula only) payable in cash shall be made at the Council Revenue located at Old Maun Administrative Authority offices. Revenue Office opens during working hours between 0730 hours and 1245 hours and from 1345 hours to 1530 hours.  
Youth persons of 18 – 35 years shall pay a non-refundable fee of P125.00 (One Hundred and Twenty-Five Pula only) of the tender price upon producing ID and any form indicating company ownership from Companies and Intellectual Property Authority (CIPA).
- The physical address for collection of Tender Documents is: Office No. 10 at Old MAA Offices – Maun.  
Tender Documents may be collected during normal working hours between 0730 hours and 1245 hours and from 1345 hours to 1630 hours, except during public holidays and weekends, with effect from 5th August, 2024.
- A compulsory tender clarification and site visit with a representative from the Procuring Entity will take place, starting at Maun Rural Administration Centre and then proceed to the Phuduhudu Community Farm on 15th August, 2024, Makalamabedi Gate at 1045 hours, Phuduhudu Farm at 1100 hours.

All queries should be in writing and deadline for the same is five (5) working days before the closing date of the tender.
- The Bid Submission Method is: One-Stage Single-Envelope Submission in which the bidder's financial and technical offers are submitted together in one sealed envelope.
- Tender offers should be submitted in three (3) sets; one (1) marked "Original" and two (2) marked "Copies" in a plain envelope securely sealed and clearly marked: "Tender No. NWDC/ELEC/60/2024-2025 – A Works Contract for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of Electric Fencing of the Phuduhudu Community Farm in the North-West District Council" and addressed to: The Accounting Officer, North-West District Council, Private Bag 01, Maun and shall be registered and deposited into a Tender Box at Procurement Unit, Office Nos. 016/017, Ground Floor, Green Block, Rural Administration Centre, Maun, not later than 0900 hours on 21st August, 2024.
- The closing time for receipt of tender offers is 0900 hours on 21st August, 2024 and opening of tenders shall be conducted immediately after closure on the same day at the Rural Administration Centre, Procurement Unit, Office Nos. 016/017.  
Late tender offers shall not be accepted.
- Late, faxed, emailed and telephonic tender offers will not be accepted.

The Public Procurement Regulatory Authority's Standardised Conditions of Tender apply to this procurement, for which all the applicable Tender Data is contained in the Tender Documents.

Bidders shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of their tender and the North-West District Council hereinafter will under no circumstances be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the tender process.
